Scott Doner then talked about domestic terrorism and named a few groups:

Scott told us to be careful of mail without return addresses, the mail sent to Scott's campus usually contained feces.

- Protestors may turn criminal and break into labs and buildings.
- Campus security personnel contact local law enforcement and have them sweep buildings for bombs
- Are campus law enforcement/security prepared to arrest a group of people?
 - make sure the paddy wagon is nearby

- flex cuffs
- have only one officer make the arrest so everyone doesn't need to go to court.
- Have bolt cutters available because these kinds of protestors like to chain themselves to things
- Do departments have access to veterinarians and dart guns in case animals are "set free?"
- Are these animals used for communicable diseases and if so, are they infected?

Scott also stressed that colleges need to have some kind of plan so that when this happens you have something to rely on. You will need to rely on people immensely.

Scott went on to talk about campus disasters and resources you may need:

- media spokesperson
- Red Cross
- Salvation Army
- Generators
